Christmas Joy Offering Display (2018 – The Perfect Gift)

Presbyterian Church (U.S.A.) display case



Once you choose a theme:

- 1. Measure the display area (case, bulletin board, window, etc.)
- 2. Make a list of materials you will need
- 3. Purchase/Gather needed materials. (see "Shopping/Gathering list" below)

For 2018 The Perfect Gift display for the Christmas Joy Offering, we used:

- Christmas Joy Offering/logo
 - Printed oversized on two pieces of 8.5x11 copy paper, and mounted on black paper
- Photos of those given assistance through the Offering, or other representation of "The Perfect Gift"

To make the gifts:

- Collect boxes in assorted sizes (determined by the space you have to work with)
- Wrap boxes in wrapping paper. We used shiny purple and a white-withsilver polka dots paper
- Mount photos on fronts of presents
- Affix bows to some of the presents

To make Christmas Joy Offering banner and "The Perfect Gift":

• Type "The Perfect Gift into Word document. Enlarge to an easily readable size for display. Print. Trim and mount to colored paper. We used black.

• Copy Christmas Joy Offering banner into Word document. Enlarge so that banner prints on multiple pages. Cut pieces and assemble to create a large banner. Adhere banner to colored paper. We used black, but another color may work better for your background/display area.

Basic Steps of the Process:

- 1. Create background for display. You may have a neutral background already, or you may need to use large sheets of paper (we used purple bulletin board paper) or other medium to cover the display area
- 2. Adhere "The Perfect Gift" letters and Christmas Joy Offering logo to back of display
- 3. If you have a display case, add a coordinating fabric
- 4. Stack gifts in bottom of case, with images facing out
- 5. Add other design elements (We used a small white Christmas tree and white garland)

Shopping/Gathering List:

- For bottom of display case:
 - Purple or white fabric
 - o Boxes
 - Wrapping paper
 - o Tape
 - o Images
 - o Bows
 - o Scissors
 - Other elements if desired
- For display wall:
 - Purple or white paper (if needed)
 - Printed and prepped letters and CJO logo
 - Printed pages
 - Black (or other color) cardstock/construction paper
 - o Stapler
 - o Tape

Not using a display case?

• This project will translate well onto a basic bulletin board. You will need to mount any additional materials that would be in the bottom of a display case, or use the floor space in front of the board.
