Giving Catalog Display Summer 2019

Presbyterian Church (U.S.A.) display case



Once you choose a theme:

1. Measure the display area (case, bulletin board, window, etc.)
2. Make a list of materials you will need
3. Purchase/Gather needed materials. (see "Shopping/Gathering list" below)

For 2019 Summer Giving Catalog display:

- We were asked to highlight Urban Farms. We chose to make a vertical garden, which works well in a narrow display case or on a wall.
- Researching types of vertical gardens, we saw that you can make them out of wooden pallets. Our print shop has a stack by the elevator, so we asked for one. We propped it in the display case since it is heavy.
 - There are lots of options for the containers: recycled plastic soda bottles, small boxes – the options are endless. You can go to Google Images and type in "vertical urban gardens" for inspiration, then use what you have on hand or can get easily and cheaply. You just need something to imitate containers on a wall, that can be easily mounted.
- We purchased imitation plants that resembled vegetable/fruit vines and herbs.
 - If you are on a tight budget, ask your congregants to bring in their yard sale fake plants!
- Copy Presbyterian Giving Catalog logo into a Word document and enlarge. Print out. Trim. Adhere to colored paper (We used yellow).
- Print out icon of the category you are highlighting. Trim.
- We also put a Giving Catalog on our display wall. You can request these by calling (502) 569-5047.
- We purchased imitation vegetables and fruits and placed them in small baskets in the base of the display case.
- We made signs and put them in acrylic stands in the base of the display case. You can mount them to the wall if that works better for you.

Basic Steps of the Process:

1. Create background for display. You may have a neutral background already, or you may need to use large sheets of paper. We orange bulletin board paper.
2. Adhere icon, Giving Catalog logo, and catalog to back of display in location shown in picture above, or a layout of your choosing.
3. If you have a display case, add a coordinating fabric to bottom (We used green to imitate grass).
4. Place baskets of fruits/veggies in bottom of case, on table, or on floor in front of display.

Shopping/Gathering List:

- For bottom of display case:
 - green fabric
 - baskets
 - imitation fruits and vegetables
 - acrylic stands
 - printouts for acrylic stands
- For display wall:
 - Bulletin board paper (if needed)(We used orange)
 - Printed and prepped wording and images
 - Printed pages
 - Red (or other color) cardstock/construction paper

- Stapler
- Container(s) for imitation plants
- Imitation plants

Not using a display case?

- This project will translate well onto a basic bulletin board. You will need to mount any additional materials that would be in the bottom of a display case or, use the floor space or table in front of the board.
