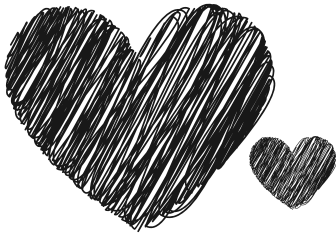




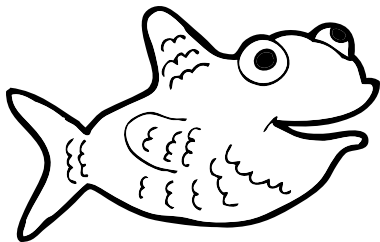
Limerick Activity Sheet

Some seeds of new hope may be _____.

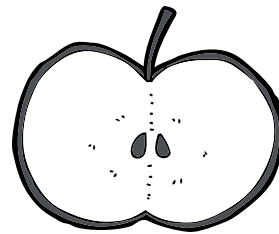


There once were people of daring,
