The gardens in Haiti are quite different from the large garden Cindy worked on the farm where she grew up in Augusta County, VA. But the crops are similar, and the love and respect Haitian farmers have for the land is the same as her father's. It is part of what drew Cindy to this work as a companionship facilitator with FONDAMA, the advocacy network in Haiti aligned with the Presbyterian Hunger Program. A major difference, though, are the struggles Haitian farmers face in keeping the land and working it. FONDAMA seeks out the root causes of Haiti's poverty such as land-grabbing and profit-robbing food imports and fight them with advocacy campaigns. "The people of Haiti work hard and are faithful to God," Cindy says. "This is humbling work."
