# Pentecost Offering Display (2018 - Stained Glass Window)

### Once you choose a theme:

- 1. Measure the display area (case, bulletin board, window, etc.).
- 2. Make a list of materials you will need.
- Purchase/Gather needed materials. (see "Shopping/Gathering list" below)

## For the 2018 Stained Glass Window display for the Pentecost Offering, we used:

  - Black/white description of Pentecost Offering
    - Printed on 8.5x11 copy paper and placed into acrylic stand for bottom of display
  - o Artwork of white dove/red flame background
    - Printed oversized and taped together to make a poster-sized image (this will depend on your display area).
- Colored paper in assorted colors, highlighting red for the Pentecost Offering/Season
- Brown colored paper cut into thin strips to mimic a window frame

#### To make the stained glass:

- Glue assorted shapes of colored paper onto larger sheets of paper, creating sections of "stained glass" to be assembled around the "poster" of the white dove/red flame. There is no exact pattern – have fun with it!
  - Try matching a window of stained glass in your church, or creating a different Pentecost-themed image in the design!

### To make Pentecost Offering banner and Bible verse:

- Copy Bible verse into Word document. Enlarge to an easily readable size for display. Print. Cut into separate words and mount to colored paper.
- Copy Pentecost Offering banner into Word document. Enlarge so that banner prints on multiple pages. Cut pieces and assemble to create a large banner. Adhere banner to colored paper.

## **Basic Steps of the Process:**

- 1. Create background for display. You may have a neutral background already, or you may need to use large sheets of a dark paper (we used black disposable tablecloth) or other medium to cover the display area.
- 2. Adhere white dove/red flame "poster" in center of display area
- 3. Adhere "stained glass" pieces around "poster" to create the illusion of a stained-glass window.
- 4. Adhere "window frame" to inside border of "stained glass"
- 5. Add titles/additional wording to display
  - a. For this display, we used the Bible verse from the 2018 Pentecost Offering poster, and the Pentecost Offering banner
- 6. If you have a display case, complete bottom of display by adding a coordinating fabric and any additional materials/signage chosen.

# **Shopping/Gathering List:**

- For bottom of display case:
  - Acrylic stand or bookholder
  - 8.5x11 Pentecost Offering description
  - Fake (or real if it works for your purpose) greenery to fill out bottom of display
  - Length of material (such as cloth) for bottom of display case
- For display wall:
  - Material to use as background (if needed)
  - Assorted colored paper
  - Brown colored paper
  - Oversized copy of white dove/red flame as poster
  - Pentecost banner
  - Bible verse pieces to adhere
  - Glue/Tape/Staples

# Not using a display case?

 This project will translate well onto a basic bulletin board. You will need to mount any additional materials that would be in the bottom of a display case. • Using a window? Paint all parts of the display onto the window. Place a small table beneath the window with additional materials.
