- Gift from God through Christ in power of Holy Spirit
- Remembrance (anamnesis) of God's grace, Christ's sacrifice, work of Spirit
- Christ's table fellowship, miracle meals
- Sign of the Kingdom/sovereign rule of God in world now as foretaste of eschatological feast
- Eucharist as thanksgiving to God for all God's acts
- Eucharist is our great sacrifice of praise to God
- Remembrance/Memorial of Christ crucified, raised, coming to rule in full glory
- Intercession that God grant all of creation grace
- * Offering of self as living sacrifice
- Communion with Trinitarian God and all the saints of past, present, future
- Preached Word enacted
- Invocation of Spirit for faith to perceive God's presence and to empower church for ministry in its sacrificial offering of service/praise
- Communion of faithful people who need nourishment of Christ
- Embraces all aspects of Christian life, demanding reconciliation of brothers and sisters, sharing in all dimensions of life (personal, ecclesial, social, political, etc.)
- Forgiveness through Christ's sacrifice for us
- Eucharist as Meal of Kingdom as vision of God's rule for all, including outcast Jesus ate and drank with
- Thanksgiving/praise that God rules!
