Baptism

Laying on of Hands [historically→Confirmation when infant baptism becomes norm] [Anointing as Ordination for Service in Christ's Holy Spirit, named/marked/sealed] [Baptismal Garment]

[Conferral of Gifts—traditionally candle with charge to walk as child of light] Welcome by congregation



Parts of Communion Liturgy

as part of offering's gift exchange after offering before last hymn

Invitation

Opening dialogue ("Lift up your hearts . . .with sursum corda Preface with praise to **God** Sanctus (= "holy") Praise for **Christ Jesus** *Anamnesis*/memorial acclamation (Remembering . .) Epiclesis (prayer for **Holy Spirit**) [The Lord's Prayer and or prayers of intercession] : Last Supper)}

{Words of institution (Jesus' words at Last Supper)} Communion (eating and drinking) Prayer after Communion (that we go forth to live according to the Lord's Table manners)
