

Housing is available for \$64 + 13.5% tax per night single or double occupancy (limited availability), at Laws Lodge on the Louisville Seminary campus. Completed in 2000, the Lodge is a spacious and comfortable, offering such in-room amenities as a private bathroom, cable television, coffee maker, radio/alarm clock, and free Wi-Fi. Iron and ironing board, a self-service laundry and kitchen are located on the halls.

Transportation between the seminary campus and Presbyterian Center will be arranged by car pool with students paying their share.

The cost of a welcome dinner and other denominational resources are included in the course fees. Other meals and incidentals are the responsibility of each student.
