Lighting the Advent Candles (Psalm Year C)

This set of readings for the lighting of the Advent candles is based on the Psalms and Canticles of the Revised Common Lectionary in Year C.

At each successive lighting of the Advent candles, all texts from the preceding lightings are read in addition to the text introduced that day.

On the First Sunday of Advent and following Sundays:

We light this candle [these candles] as a sign of the coming light of Christ.

Blessed are you, O God,

Luke 1

for you have looked favorably upon your people.

You give light to those who wait in darkness, and you guide us in paths of peace.

To you, O Lord, we lift up our souls; O God, in you we trust.

Psalm 25

And on the Second Sunday of Advent, and at successive lightings:

By your tender mercy, O God,

Luke 1

the dawn from on high will break upon us.

And on the Third Sunday of Advent, and at successive lightings:

You are our salvation, O God; you are our strength and our might.

Isaiah 12

And on the Fourth Sunday of Advent, and at successive lightings:

O Lord, our souls magnify your name;

Luke 1

our spirits rejoice in you, O God our Savior.

And on the eve of Christmas, or on Christmas Day:

Now your light has dawned upon us, and our hearts are filled with joy.

Psalm 97

On each occasion the lighting of the candles is concluded with:

Sing praises to the Lord, who has done glorious things!

Isaiah 12

Shout aloud and sing for joy, for the Holy One is with us.
