

We Believe Workshop objectives

Moses: Baby in a Basket

The **Art Workshop** explores Exodus 1:15–2:10 through creative art experiences.

Objectives of the Workshop

The children will have the opportunity to:

- Place figures on a felt/flannel board to help tell the story of the baby Moses.
- Hear the story of baby Moses and the women who helped him.
- Name people who care for them.
- Think of ways they care for others as one of God's helpers.
- Weave a basket.

The **Audiovisual Workshop** explores Exodus 1:15–2:10 through audiovisual media that is heard, viewed or made.

Objectives of the Workshop

The children will have the opportunity to:

- Hear and see the story of how Moses was saved by five faithful women.
- Watch an excerpt of the movie *The Prince of Egypt*.
- Think about how the five women took care of Moses.
- Think about who has taken care of them.
- Identify "caretakers" in their congregation.

The **Computer Workshop** explores Exodus 1:15–2:10 using computers.

Sometimes computers are used to tell the story, and sometimes they are used to respond to it.

Objectives of the Workshop

The children will have the opportunity to:

- Use a computer and Kid Pix Studio Deluxe, 3rd Edition software to do a word search puzzle.
- Hear Moses' story told using simple props.
- Use a computer to create a thank-you card for a caregiver.

The **Drama/Storytelling Workshop** explores Exodus 1:15–2:10 by retelling the story in ways that help children remember it.

Objectives of the Workshop

The children will have the opportunity to:

- Try some dramatic improvisation activities.
- Hear the story of baby Moses and the women who cared for him.
- Consider the feelings of the women who cared for baby Moses and why they did what they did.

The Games and Puzzles Workshop explores Exodus 1:15—2:10 by having children play biblically related games or puzzles.

Objectives of the Workshop

The children will have the opportunity to:

- Use tangrams to explore problem-solving skills.
- Use a variety of active cooperative games to practice working together.
- Learn the names and the roles of the five women who saved Moses' life and explore the challenges they faced.
- Discover five messages that God has for us today.

The Music and Worship Workshop explores Exodus 1:15—2:10 through music and makes the connection to worship in PC(USA) congregations.

Objectives of the Workshop

The children will have the opportunity to:

- Learn a song about how God remembers and protects God's children.
- Learn sign language to go with the song "I Will Be With You."
- Hear the story of how God used five women to protect and nurture young Moses.
- Participate in writing cinquain poems about each of the characters in the story.

The Bonus: Discovery Workshop explores Exodus 1:15—2:10 with activities that help children learn about mission and how the church's mission is carried out in and through the PC(USA). This workshop also gives children an opportunity to explore their own role in mission.

Objectives of the Workshop

The children will have the opportunity to:

- Help tell the story of the baby Moses and the women who cared for him.
- Learn about caring for babies.
- Make a baby hat that will be donated to an agency in their area that cares for babies.
